RazakSat is a “Designed in Malaysia” Earth-Observation Low-Earth-Orbit (LEO) satellite that was launched into near-equatorial orbit in 2009 by SpaceX’s Falcon-1 rocket.

PIKOM aims to become the central voice of the SpaceTech industry based on its expertise in the technology sectors and system-integration expertise which are the backbone of the SpaceTech and satellite engineering.

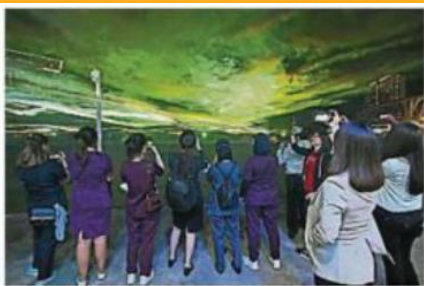
